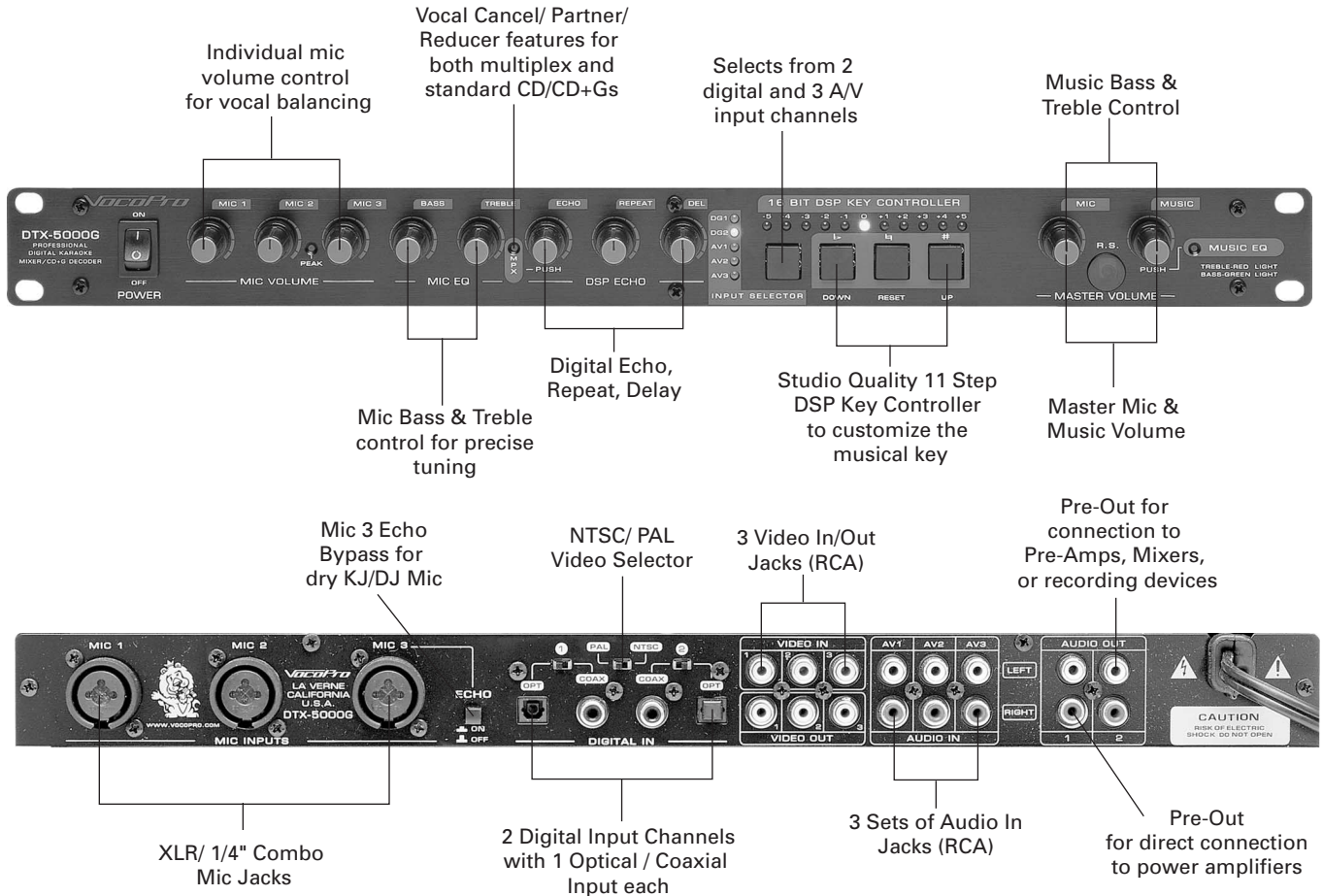


DTX-5000G

Professional Digital Karaoke Mixer/ CD+G Decoder



Understanding Decoder Compatibility:

The first and foremost requirement for compatibility with CD+G decoders is Digital Output. Your source player must have either a Coaxial or Optical Output jack in order to feed CD subcode (graphical data) to the CD+G decoder (DTX-5000G). **Basically, if there is no Digital Output, there will be no CD+G decoding.** Secondly, if you don't already know, it is highly recommended to find out if your source player is equipped with a Digital Shock Buffer (most common in mobile DJ units). Most Digital Shock Buffers do not recognize CD subcode and do to this, **players with Digital Shock Buffers are not likely to work with a CD+G decoder.** If you are unsure if your player has a Digital Shock Buffer or not, please contact the manufacturer of the player for details.
